The ability to vote for who is sitting in the oval office every four years is important, however, voting in state, local, and regional elections is important, too. Mail-In Ballots are Now Available!

As of **September 1st**, you may request a mail-in ballot. Who is eligible?

- You are 65 years or older on Election Day.
- You are sick or disabled. Your disability must be a sickness or physical condition that prevents the voter from appearing at the polling place on election day without a likelihood of needing personal assistance or of injuring the voter's health.
- You will be out of the county in which you are registered both during in-person early voting AND on Election Day.
- You are expected to give birth within three weeks before or three weeks after Election Day
- You are in jail, but still eligible to vote.

Ballots MUST be postmarked by **October 28th**. Check out the [PHNTX blog](#) for EVERYTHING you need to know about mail-in ballots!

Important Dates to Remember:

- September 1st – Mail-in ballots available
- September 20th – National Voter Registration Day
- October 11th – Last day to register to vote
- October 28th – Mail-in ballots must be postmarked
- Oct. 24th-Nov. 4th – Early Voting
- November 8th – Election Day
